Incandescent version may be dimmed with a standard incandescent dimmer. LED version may be dimmed with a LED dimmer. Consult lamp manufacturer for additional information.

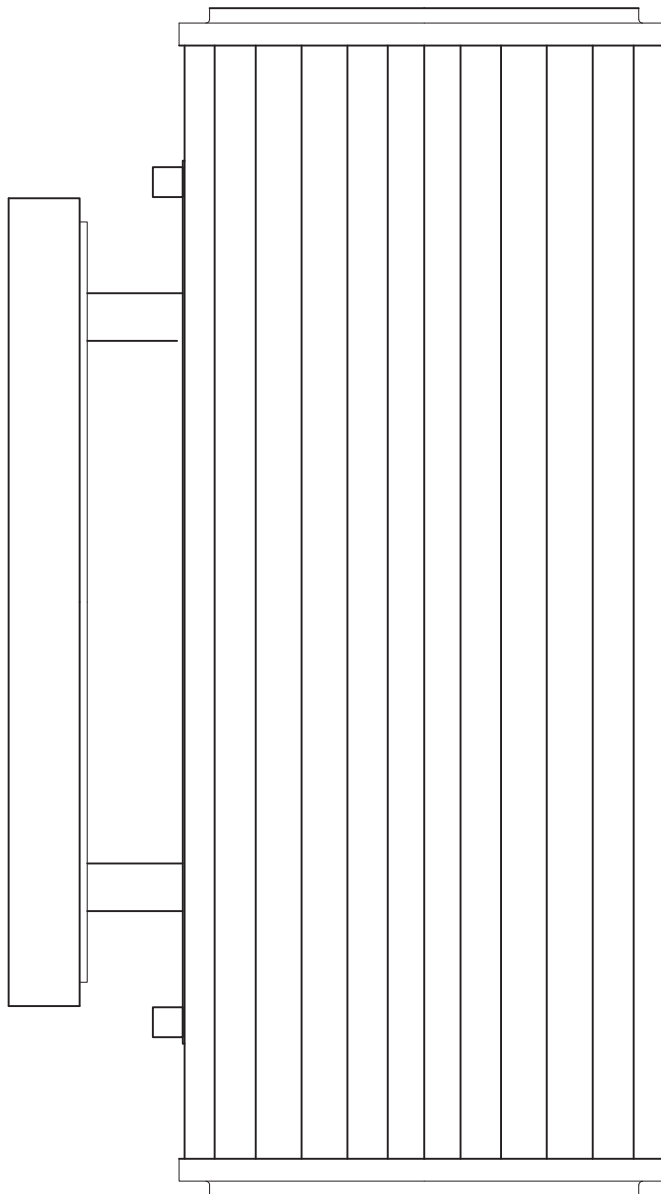

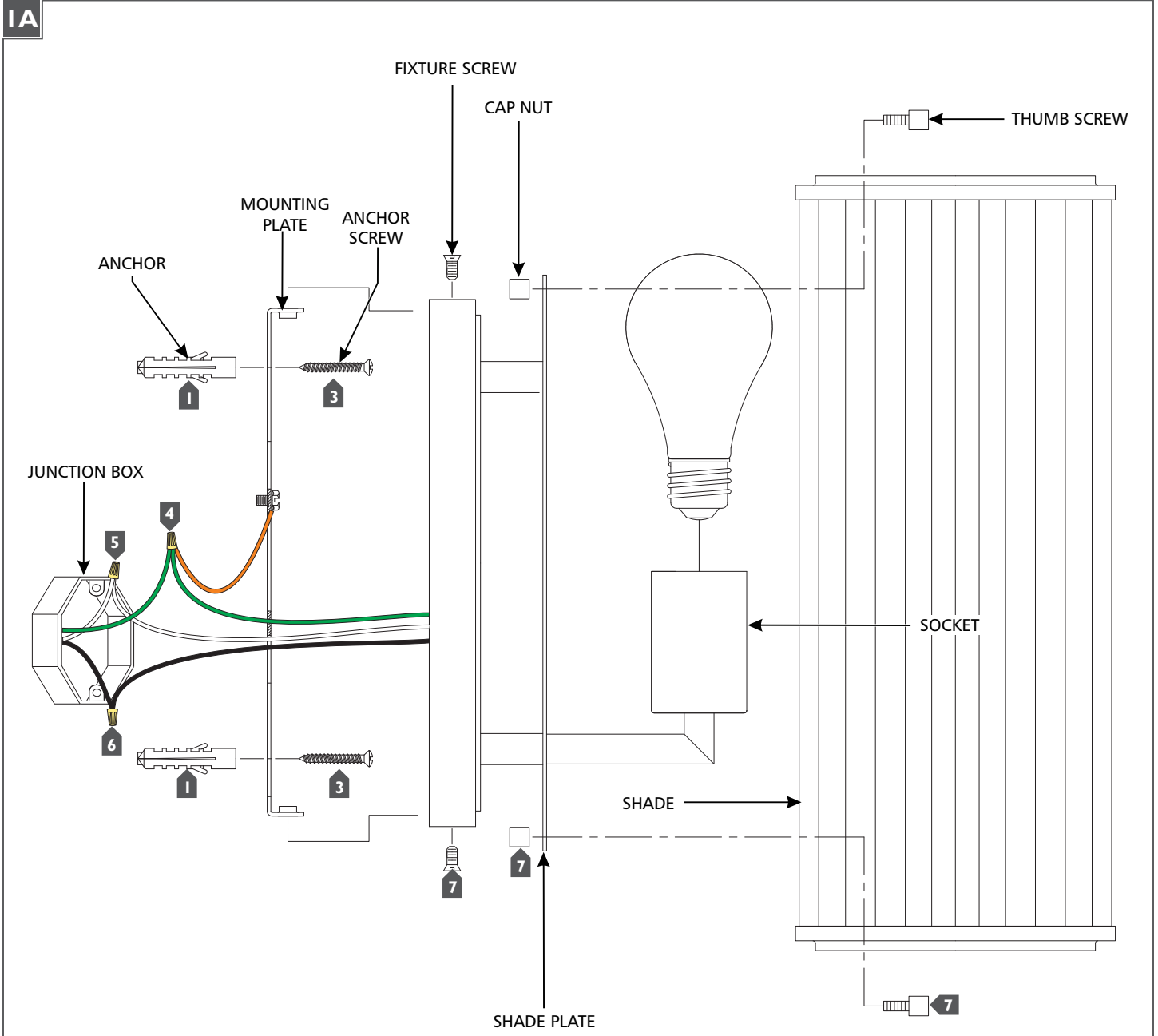

# Install the Fixture



- 1 Temporarily secure the mounting plate to the junction box and mark the location of the anchors, then remove the mounting plate.
- 2 Drill appropriate sized holes at the marked locations and install the anchors.
- 3 Secure the mounting plate to the junction box and screw the anchor screws through the anchors.
- 4 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 5 Connect the white fixture wire (square and/or rigid) to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 6 Connect the black fixture wire (round and/or smooth) to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- 7 Neatly place all the wires into the junction box, place the canopy onto the mounting plate, and secure it in place using the fixture screw.
- 8 Screw the lamp into the socket. Refer to the label on the lamp socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 9 Install the shade by placing it over the socket then inserting thumb screws through the shade and shade plate. Secure the thumb screws with the cap nuts.
